DOCUMENTS NEEDED FROM YOUR STUDENT'S SCHOOL BEFORE LEAVING:

Before departing your current location, please ensure that you obtain the information below. Hand-carry these records, do not pack. If you have any issues obtaining records, contact your current installation's SLO office.

- Provide current school your official withdrawal date
- Obtain an unofficial copy of all of your records (testing, advanced placement, IEPs, 504 plans, etc.)
- Transcript/Record Documentation Requirements (Ensure information is annotated).
- State/Standardized or Special Program Testing
- Advanced Placement Courses/Dual Credit
- IEPs/504 Plan
- Gifted & Talented Classes
- Working outside of grade level (i.e., taking 10th-grade math but in the 8th grade)
- On the day of withdrawal – obtain an unofficial transcript/records (listed above) with grades closed out as of that day - (if departing during summer break – ensure copy states passed/promoted and obtain before office closure).

Other documents to obtain:

- Immunization records
- Report Card/Course History/Schedule
- Counselor Recommendations for Placement
- JROTC Records (if applicable)
- List of Academic Recognition/Competition Participation

If you are currently overseas and enrolled in a DoDEA Non-DoD Schools Program (NDSP) School, please obtain a duplicate transcript from DoDEA that will transfer correctly into the American public system. DoDEA will pay for if you have not exhausted your funds.

Contact your School Liaison Office at your gaining installation if there are any issues during the transition.
